Oral presentations-

- The abstract due date for oral presentation entry is **April 14, 2019**
- Clinical, basic science, medical education research projects and QI projects carried out at Duke are eligible for oral presentation entry
- Supporting letter from mentor with whom you carried out the work is required
- Supporting mentor letters are addressed to "The Califf Medicine Resident Research Award Committee" and emailed to Dr. Arcasoy
- A faculty committee will review and score each abstract. The scores will be tallied and the top **three abstracts** will be selected for oral presentation
- The award is \$500 to each of the 3 selected presenters
- You can submit more than one abstract for different projects
- Please email Dr. Arcasoy: <u>murat.arcasoy@duke.edu</u> with any questions and to submit the abstract and supporting mentor letters
- Case vignettes are not presented during the oral session but welcome as posters

Poster presentations-

- If you are presenting a poster, you do NOT need a mentor's letter
- You are encouraged to submit an abstract for oral presentation as above AND present a poster of the same work
- You do NOT need to submit an abstract of your poster, just prepare your poster and drop it off in the MedRes office by May 2nd. We will hang them for you.
- Please sign up to present a poster (we will send a qualtrix to sign up) so we can order correct number of poster display boards. You can present > 1 poster
- We will help you print your posters and cover the cost of printing
- Three posters will be selected for best poster awards by the Chief Residents during the poster session on May 3rd beginning at 7 am
- For poster presentation: research projects, case studies/vignettes, quality improvement projects are all welcome
- Poster presenters selected for the best posters will be awarded \$250 each. There will be a total of 3 poster awards
- Previously presented posters (eg at ACP meeting or other subspecialty meetings) are especially welcome. Please drop them off at the MedRes office
