
IMMIGRANTS ARE ESSENTIAL To Help Solve the National Health Care Worker Shortage

H.R.3541 & S.1810 - Conrad State 30 & Physician Access Reauthorization Act

Allow medical trainees on student visas to work in underserved areas and academic medical centers and apply for immigrant visas or permanent residence.

H.R.2255 & S.1024 - Healthcare Workforce Resilience Act

Allow nurses and physicians on the front lines of the COVID-19 pandemic to apply for previously unused immigrant visas

H.R.1909 & S.747 - Citizenship for Essential Workers Act

Allow COVID-19 public health essential workers to apply for and obtain permanent resident status.
